**SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 59**

**PROPOSITION C**

Shall the Board of Education of the Mexico School District No. 59, Missouri, be authorized to eliminate fully the Proposition C Sales Tax Rollback in its operating levy under Section 164.013 R.S.Mo. in order to replace and offset State funding reductions, continue existing programs, retain qualified staff, maintain its facilities and meet the operating expenses of the District?

(If this proposition is approved the adjusted operating levy of the School District could increase from \$2.9545, currently, to \$3.43 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the 2012 Tax Year and to be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter.)
